IQAC plays a significant role in the functioning of the college, for the effective execution of all the activities. IQAC strives to follow participatory policy. The year 2020-21 proved challenging for the educational sector as Covid 19 pandemic halted offline classes. This pandemic also paved the way for new and innovative ideas to implement. IQAC of the college worked hard to enable learning go on. For online teaching-learning process, the online platforms such as Zoom and Google Meet were used. Online classes and programs were conducted through these apps, four meetings of IQAC held during the year.

Training to Teachers: Training to use online platforms especially Zoom and Google Meet was given to the teaching faculty.

Online Examinations: IQAC planned to conduct online examination as per University guidelines. Exam committee conducted exams in close association with the IQAC. Continuous interaction between these two enabled the college to conduct exams fairly and declare results in time.

Faculty Development Program: Faculties allowed to attend online FDPs. Teaching staff attended and successfully completed 47 online Refresher Course, Orientation Course, FDP and Short Term Courses. These made faculty members to implement new strategies while conducting online classes.
